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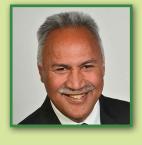

Chair's Report

As Chair of the Hutt Mana Charitable Trust I am pleased to submit the annual report to our shareholding communities in Porirua, Wellington North and the Hutt Valley.

In this financial year we have granted 217 funding applications to the value of \$813,147.60.

In addition to that support for grass roots community organisations, trustees have been proud to continue to support the practical application of the energy and home heating research conducted by Otago University over the last fifteen years. Our support of Sustainability Trust's household energy efficiency work is dedicated to making the biggest difference in increasing the temperature in the greatest number of homes in our area to support the health of people. That work is ongoing and is supplemented by more specific work in the hardest to reach homes in Wainuiomata, which require more comprehensive building and heating investment. We were pleased to assist University of Otago to promote their work through a recent BBC documentary which covered the importance of the University's mahi in driving the research for warm dry homes.

The trust is committed to assisting more young people gain their driver licenses within the Hutt Mana district. The social and economic benefit of having a license is undeniable, and this year the trust has funded evidential investigations to measure its contributions in this area. This support will be targeted through schools and NGOs where students may struggle to fund licensing or have reduced access to a vehicle. We expect to grow the amount we invest in licensing in future financial years.

Hutt Mana Charitable Trust employs no staff, but instead contracts a secretariat to assist with all administration and finance support. Trustees also have a hands-on role in running aspects of the trust's day to day activities. All of our grant applications are now online, which has improved the process of applications for our grantees and reduced costs for the trust.

The end of our financial year shows another strong year of granting to the Hutt Mana communities, although it is coupled with a reduction in our asset value, due to global market performance.

Current trustees are wishing to grow in real terms, the value of the assets over time, while not compromising on grants to our communities. This will not be smooth, particularly at times of market volatility. While the value of our assets have decreased by 10% in this year, we have lost the 10% gained in the previous financial year. In such circumstances it is the role of trustees to be prudent in keeping our operating costs contained and focussing on the long term picture.

Notes to the Financial Statements
